Antiquing

gently so as not to destroy proof of age. Avoid caustics (lye) as they will turn cherry, walnut and mahogany dark. And it's extremely dangerous. Be very careful with veneer so as not to loosen it as it is very hard to reglue. Especially avoid water-based paint removers on veneered furniture, at least till you're an expert.

I, myself, have refinished about 500 pieces of furniture, a count I made several years ago.

And I was shocked to find out how many pieces they had added up to over the years. But I have found only one final answer and that is that there is no final answer. All woods are different, some come up with a beautiful tone, others just won't come out at all. I've used almost all of the paint removers, stains and finishes. Sometimes I've sanded heavily, sometimes practically not at all. It seems to be a matter of judgment based on experience. The more pieces you do, the more of a "feel" you'll get for it.

And when you buy professionally finished pieces you must expect them to be right. After all a professional is not an amateur and must be better or he couldn't stay in business.

An excellent book on refinishing is "The Furniture Doctor" by George Grotz which sells for \$4.95. You can order it from any dealer who carries books on antiques. Or send a large, self-addressed stamped (12c) envelope for my list of good books on antiques.
