State Tightens Milk Sanitation Regulations


The State Department of Agriculture has adopted revised sanitary regulations on quality controls over milk produced in Pennsylvania

Principally, the changes of particular importance to consumers involved tighter bacteria standards and more rlgid temperature controls for milk in storage and in transit. It is the first such change in 10 years

The new standards reduce by 50 per cent the permissable count of bacteria in raw milk delivered to the processing plants

In pasteurized milk, the permissible count of bacteria has been reduced by one-third.

Under the new regulations, the temperatures of milk shipped from farms in bulk tanks may not exceed 40 degrees Fahrenheit, and the temperature of processed milk may not exceed 45 degrees in storage or 50 degrees in transit.




