

State Corn Supply Up May 5 Scholarship Date

Stocks of all grains in Pennsylvania on April 1, excluding rice and soybeans, were at 613 million bushels comparing with 511 million a year ago.

Corn stocks were up 38 per cent while soybean stocks were down 19 per cent and barley down three per cent.

May 5 is the deadline for application for eight \$400 Lancaster County Farm and Home Foundation scholarships for high school seniors desiring to further their education in the fields of agriculture and home economics.

State Tightens Milk Sanitation Regulations

The State Department of Agriculture has adopted revised sanitary regulations on quality controls over milk produced in Pennsylvania.

Principally, the changes of particular importance to consumers involved tighter bacteria standards and more rigid temperature controls for milk in storage and in transit. It is the first such change in 10 years.

The new standards reduce by 50 per cent the permissible count of bacteria in raw milk delivered to the processing plants.

In pasteurized milk, the permissible count of bacteria has been reduced by one-third.

Under the new regulations, the temperatures of milk shipped from farms in bulk tanks may not exceed 40 degrees Fahrenheit, and the temperature of processed milk may not exceed 45 degrees in storage or 50 degrees in transit.

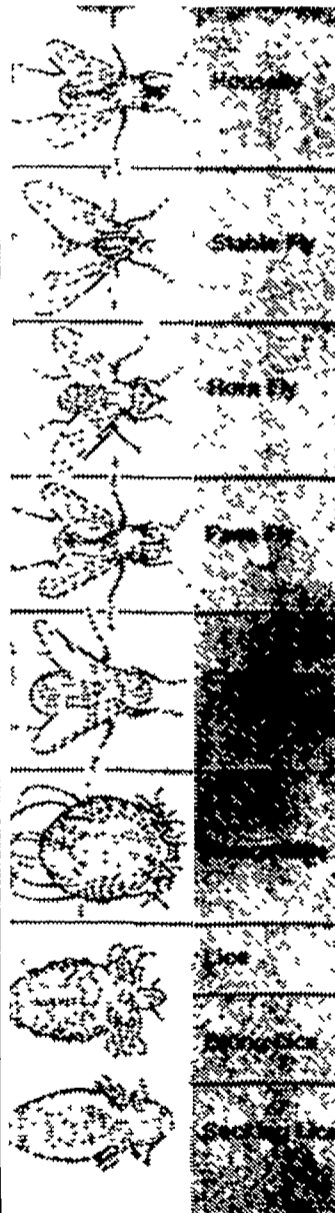
