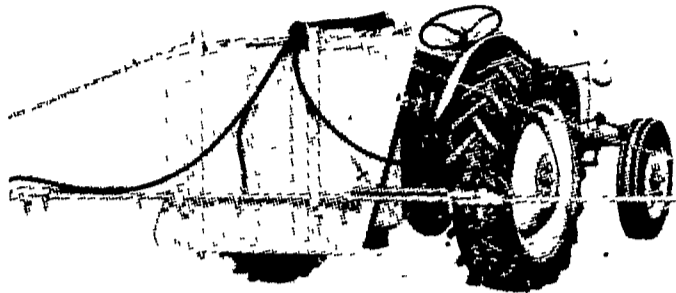

### Pesticide Manufacturer Appeals USDA Decision

A pesticide manufacturer The Noiam Co of Chicago Ill, has appealed the U.S. Department of Agriculture's decision to suspend registration of alkylmercury fungicides for use as seed treatment.

These mercury products have been used for controlling disease organisms that attack seeds and seedlings. Pending final determination following the appeal procedure, the products may not be shipped or sold in interstate commerce.

The company produced and sold its mercury products in interstate commerce under such brand names as Panogen, Pandinox, Panodim, Panocoat and EP-398.
