She will reign at the 1971 Pennsylvania Farm Show and receive an expenses paid trip to represent Pennsylvania in the National contest.

The many prizes of the national winner will include \$2,000.

Representing almost 100,000 dairy industry members, the Pennsylvania Dairy Princess Contest is the largest "Agricultural Queen" contest in the state.

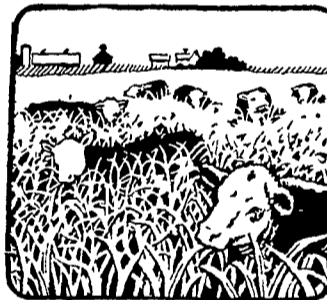

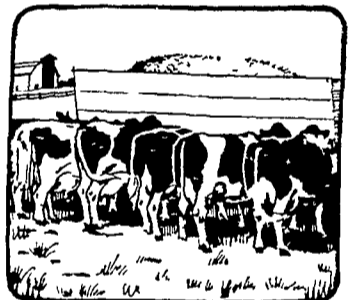
