

Bucher, Lebanon FFA Member, Spending 3 Months in Europe

Stan Bucher of Lebanon departed for Sweden Thursday, June 11 to spend three summer months as an exchange student in the FFA's Work Experience Abroad program, according to the National FFA Center.

Prior to leaving for Sweden, he met with the Royal Swedish Agricultural Attache along with 25 other FFA members last week at the National FFA Center in Alexandria, Virginia.

Following this orientation, also

attended by seven other European Attaches, Stan and the FFA members departed Dulles International Airport for London. They travelled by boat and train from London to their host families.

Midway in his three month stay in Sweden, Bucher will travel to Frankfurt, Germany, where he will join other exchange students for a mid-point

conference followed by an agri-

cultural tour of Denmark, Holland, Germany, and Sweden. This tour is being arranged by the FFA in cooperation with other youth organizations in Europe.

Stan is the son of M.s Sara Bucher of Lebanon.

He was a member of the Little Dutchman FFA Chapter of Annville where his advisor was Peter Boyer. Bucher plans to return to Washington on September 14 for an Evaluation Conference prior to returning home.

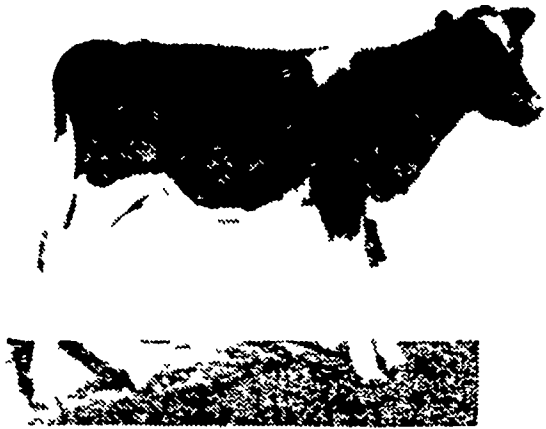
Poultry Federation Cites Lancaster Egg Promotion
