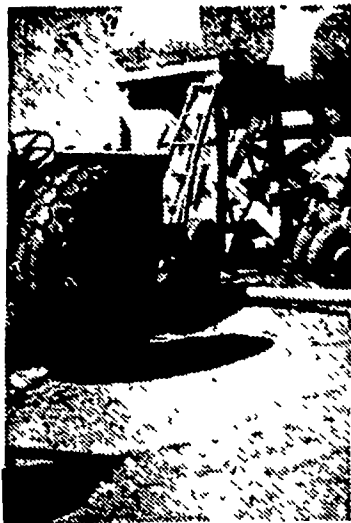

600 to Attend Grange School at Gettysburg

A five-state affair for the first time, the Pennsylvania State Grange 47th annual leadership school June 23-25 at Gettysburg College will have an enrollment of over 600 persons making it second in size only to the older annual state convention. A Wayne Reed, N.C. master said recently

Combined with the school will be the Middle Atlantic Lecturers' Conference of which Miss Mildred E. Shultz, Somerset, lecturer of the State Grange, is president. Some 300 of these delegates from New York, New Jersey, Delaware, Maryland and Pennsylvania will be guests of the school, taking part in its program along with Grange officials from most of the 628 subordinate bodies throughout the state.

Miss Shultz and chairmen of three other Grange leadership areas, Mrs. Ross Metz, Allensville, women's activities; Mrs. Alan Merkel, Kutztown RD3, Junior Grange, and Mr. and Mrs. James E. Diamond, Ottsville RD1, youth work, will head workshops dealing with their departments and around which the school's four main divisions will function.

Readinger said the school and conference, running concurrently, will open with the dedication the first afternoon of a memorial in Gettysburg National Park Cemetery to William T. Saun-

ders, its architect and a founder of the National Grange. William J. Brake, Haslett, Mich., lecturer of the National Grange, will speak. This will follow nearly three years after the project was initiated with a ceremony, November, 1967, at which Governor Raymond P. Shafer was speaker.

Meeting on the Gettysburg campus for the fourth successive year, the school will be welcomed by college officials. Dormitories will house delegates and the dining commons will provide food service.
