

Local Senior Aged Holstein Is Record Producer

The Holstein-Friesian Association of America has announced that Bayfield Ty Grawin Johanna 3932472 (EX 3E), owned by J Mowery Frey & Son, Fultonway Farm, Lancaster, has completed the fifth highest official national butterfat record made by a Senior Aged Registered Holstein milked twice daily in both the 305-day and 365-day division of the DHIR program.

Her official 305-day production totalled 21,150 pounds of milk and 908 pounds of butterfat. She continued to milk for a 365-day record of 23,528 pounds of milk and 1,009 pounds of butterfat.

"Johanna" was bred in the herd of George F Causey, Bayfield Farm, Wakefield, Rhode Island. She was sired by Osbornedale Ivanhoe 1189870 (EX), a bull that has earned Gold Medal Sire recognition.

Topping this age group in butterfat in both the 305-day and 365-day divisions is Penstate Lucifer Anna Star 3279562, a Registered Holstein owned by Pennsylvania State University, University Park. Milked twice daily, she produced 23,294 pounds of milk and 1,048 pounds of butterfat in 305 days and 25,612 pounds of milk and 1,163 pounds of butterfat in 365 days.

The national Association also announced career food production totals for Registered Holstein cows in this area exceeding 100,000 pounds (46,500 quarts) of milk.

The official testing program is sponsored by the Association and supervised by the state and local testing organizations.

Because of the high cost for herd replacements, cows that stay in the herd longer and achieve high lifetime production have proven to be more profitable. The Holstein Association has 35,500 cows on file that have attained the 50-ton production milestone.

Fultonway Sovereign Blossom 3876811 (VG), 131,496 pounds of milk and 5,460 pounds of butterfat in 4,150 days; Fultonway Lucifer Daisy 4520847 (GP), 123,076 pounds of milk and 5,123 pounds of butterfat in 2,899 days; Fultonway Ivanhoe Lady 5345698 (VG), 110,004 pounds of milk and 5,460 pounds of butterfat in 2,533 days. All are owned by J Mowery Frey & Son, Fultonway Farms, Lancaster.

Groffdale Reflection Delight 5369916 (EX), 115,663 pounds of milk and 4,290 pounds of butterfat in 2,533 days; Groffdale Reflection Ina 5369917 (GP), 107,462 pounds of milk and 4,121 pounds of butterfat in 2,442 days. Both are owned by Robert C Groff, Groffdale Farm, Quarryville.

Corncroft Fancy R A Burke 3999431 (GP), 148,338 pounds of milk and 6,752 pounds of butterfat in 4,424 days; Henkel Reflection Dee 5397057 (GP), 106,872 pounds of milk and 4,670 pounds of butterfat in 2,259 days; Henkel Dean Fess 5426631 (GP), 102,195 pounds of milk and 4,007 pounds of butterfat in 2,228 days. Trout Spring Lad Beets Becky 5199346 (GP), 108,720 pounds of milk and 4,057 pounds of butterfat in 2,625 days. She is owned by John E Kreider, Lancaster.

Blossomelle Gay Dorinda 4792596 (GP), 105,713 pounds of milk and 4,929 pounds of butterfat in 3,265 days. She is owned by Herbert & Rhelda E Royer, Lancaster.

Valley Run Regal Hazel 4821-274 (GP), 108,460 pounds of milk and 5,573 pounds of butterfat in 3,296 days. She is owned by Arthur D & May K Wenger, Manheim.

The 2,944th yearly production record exceeding a half ton of butterfat has been completed by a Registered Holstein cow, Hartog Osbornedale Lauxmont 5321779 (VG), owned by J Mowery Frey & Son.

The Pennsylvania Holstein's official record of production totalled 23,639 pounds of milk and 1,064 pounds of butterfat in 3,265 days. She started her lactation at the age of 9 years 6 months and was milked twice daily.

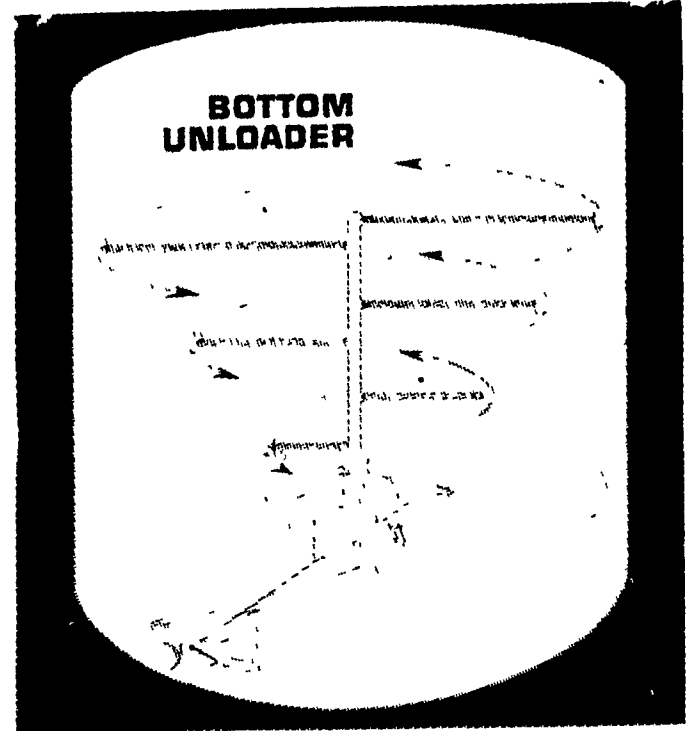

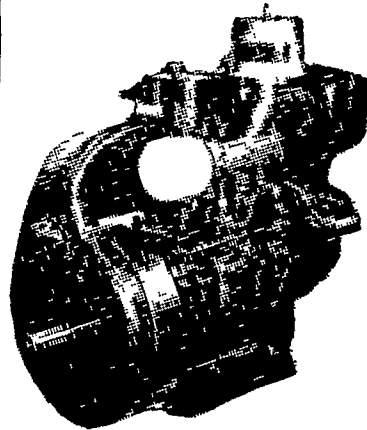
