Prices lower on medium, barely steady on large. Undertone weak and unsettled. Receipts light due to dealer restrictive policies in force until some improvement noted. Offerings of mediums continuing longest and most burdensome position and occasionally offered down to 26c (In used cases) in effort to clear. Large ample with extra large in slightly better balance and currently selling at 46 49c. Large browns cleared late yesterday at 44 45 1/2c. Smalls ample. Demand for bulk eggs slow with a wait and see attitude prevailing while carton orders were of a just fair slightly disappointing nature.
