

# Visitor Describes Farming in Turkey

Huseyin, who is graduating now from college in Istanbul, having majored in business administration.

They have 4-H clubs similar to ours. They are more active in villages than in towns. They also have hunting clubs in the villages. They hunt rabbits and birds such as pheasants, wild ducks, and wild pigs because the pigs are harmful to the farms.

Taxes are high. They have income tax and a tax on cigarettes,

tea, drinks and a movie tax but no sales tax.

Citizens, both men and women, over 21 have the right to vote. They have two Assemblies—Representatives and the Senate. They have elections every four years and elect Representatives who must be at least a graduate of a Junior High School. Senate members who must be a college graduate and a President. The National Assembly makes the laws. The Senate can O.K. them then they go to the President.

The Prime Minister is busier than the President. He appoints the cabinet like our President does.

A certain part of their cities is just shops, not department stores like we have. Market days are a certain day of the week when food is cheaper. Grocery stores sell only fresh fruit and vegetables. A bakkol is similar to our grocery store except no fresh fruit and vegetables are sold there.

Gas, electric and gasoline is used for cooking. These fuels plus wood and coal are used for heating the homes. They have all kinds of appliances in their homes except dishwashers

The population is 98 per cent of the Moslem religion. All Turks are Moslem. There are a few Greeks and Jews. There is no race problem but Moslems rarely marry outside their nationality. The young people date as in America and select their mates; however, they must have the approval of the parents for marriage. New Year's Eve is celebrated but not Christmas.

There are German, French and American schools in addition to Turkish schools in Turkey. Rahime's father insisted that she go to an American school which means she must take two extra years in Junior High School and one extra in Senior High School

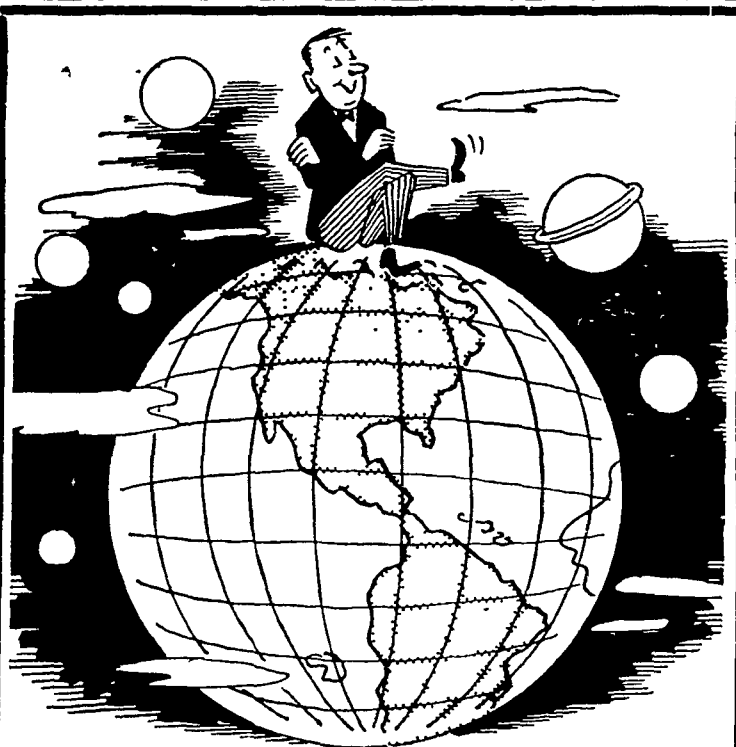
to learn the language. She has been in the American school eight years and could teach English after graduation but she doesn't care to do that.

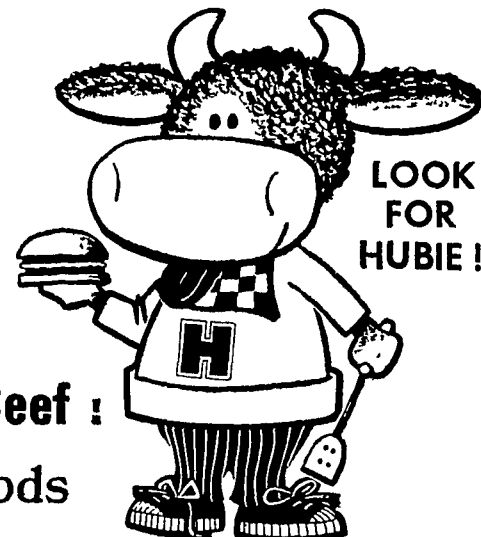
