During the meeting, the  
Foundation noted the success  
of its recent letter of reminder  
to the leading contributors to  
the Center and voted to send

tion which netted almost \$1,500.

It was indicated that the  
auction proved itself and will  
probably be repeated next  
year Several members said  
they have had indications of in-  
creased support for next year,  
including additional buyers and  
word from some 4-H girls that  
they want to be in the auction,  
too All the slaves who donated  
their labor this year were young  
men

The Foundation voted to  
draft a resolution recognizing  
the work of the late John H.  
Herr
