root worm and the leaf blights have made their appearances. I don't think anyone is ready to quit growing corn for livestock feeding purposes, but it is possible to sow winter barley this fall and get a crop early next summer. Barley is one of the best substitutes for corn in most rations. Barley yields are usually worthwhile in southeastern Pennsylvania and worthy of more consideration. The straw is badly needed.

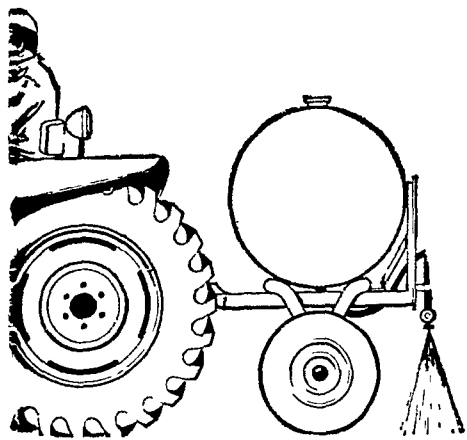

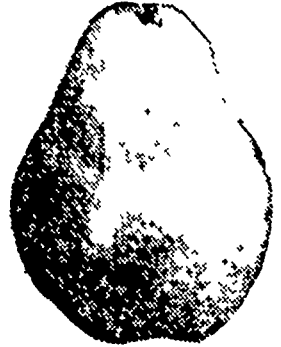

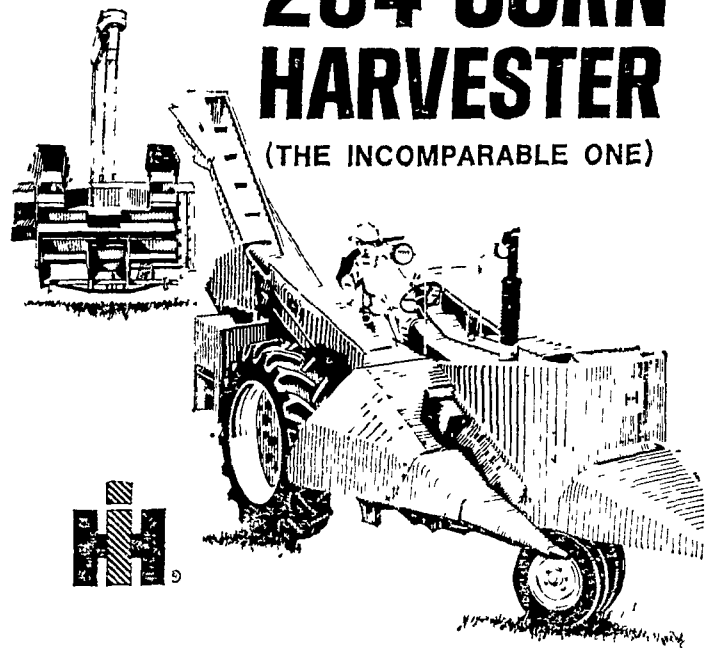
