Chester Delaware Pomona also had contestants receiving honorable mention.

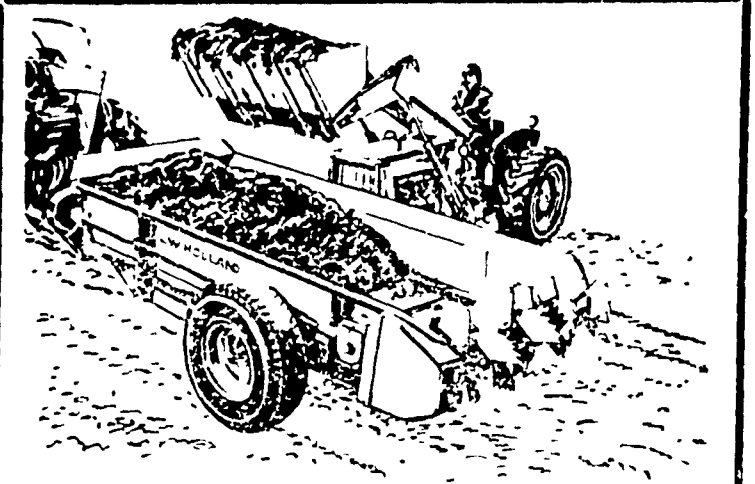

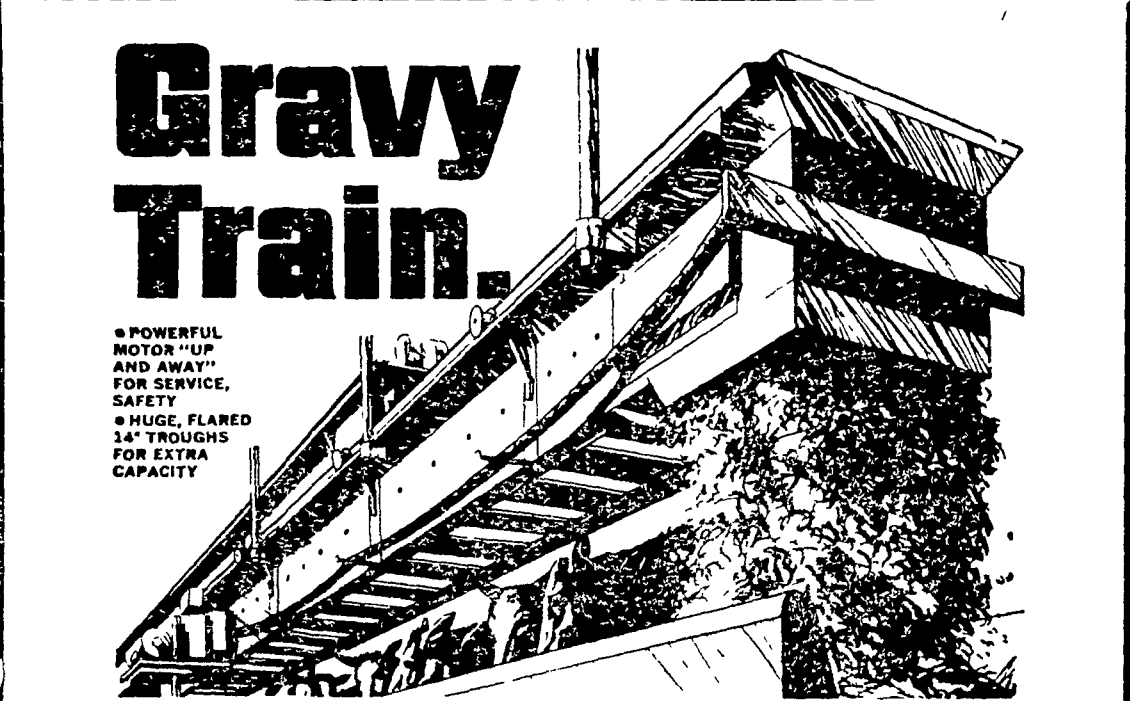

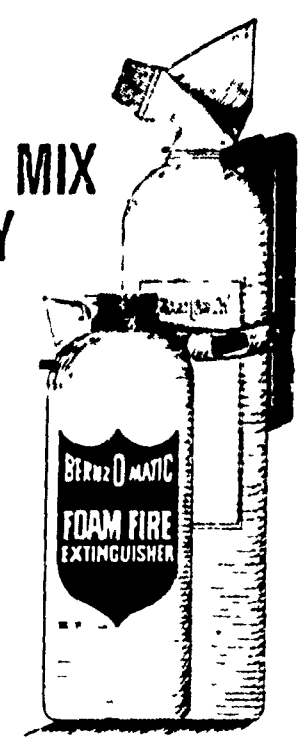
