

USDA Suspends Milk Diversion Rules in Sept.

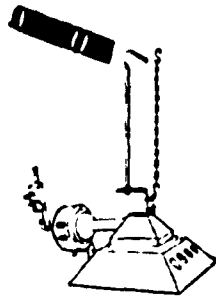
The U. S. Department of Agriculture suspended for September a provision of the Mid-Atlantic milk marketing order that sets limits on the amount of milk that dealers may divert to manufacturing plants not regulated by the order.

The action permits more milk to be shipped directly from farms to manufacturing plants, without first having to go to regulated distributing plants. Officials of USDA's Consumer and Marketing Service said it was necessary because a late opening of Philadelphia school cafeterias reduced the amount of milk needed for fluid use during September.

Requested by Inter State Milk Producers Cooperative, Inc., the action was proposed by USDA in the September 19 Federal Register. No comments from interested persons opposed it, C&MS officials said.

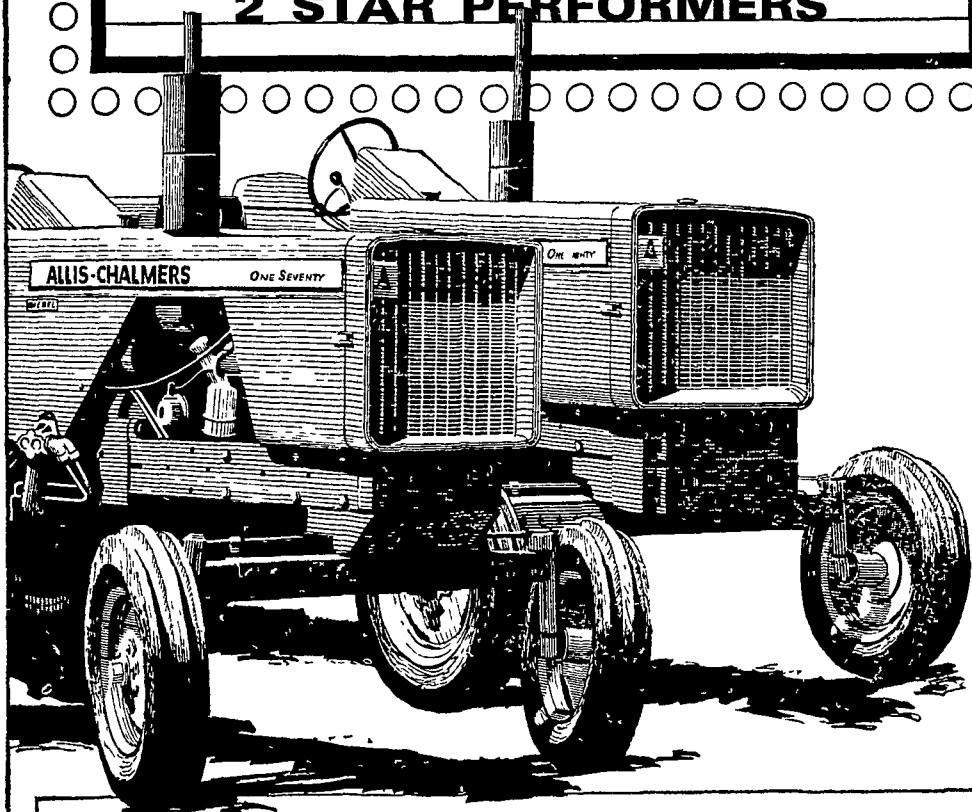

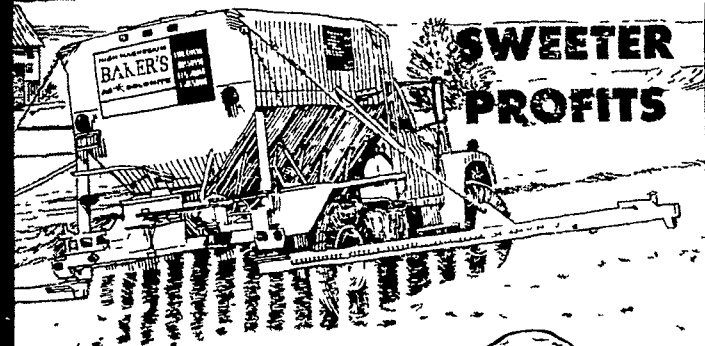
