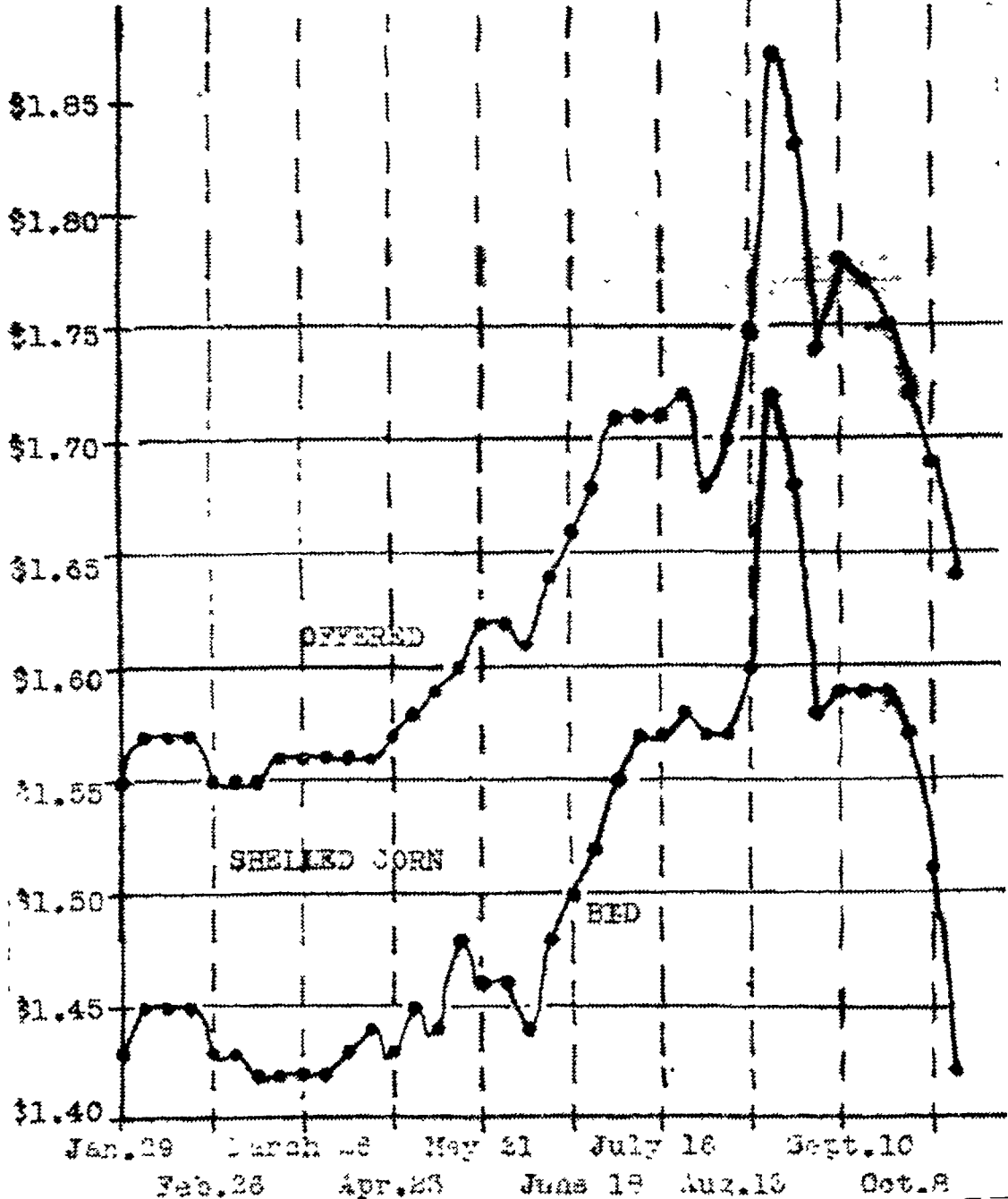

CATTLE — Compared with last Friday, slaughter steers steady to 25 higher, the advance on weights under 1150 lbs, slaughter heifers steady to strong. Cows 50 higher. Bulls steady.

Receipts included 70 percent slaughter steers and 27 percent heifers with balance mostly cows. Overall finish slaughter steers not as attractive as last week with 12 percent prime and 73 percent choice, compared with 15 percent prime and 78 percent choice last week and 15 percent prime and 75 percent choice last year. Average cost and weight slaughter steers estimated.
