If a sample is sent to another section (such as Entomology) and they can give an answer, no charge is made If they send the sample on to the Clinic. a \$2.50 per sample charge is made. County Agents and Extension Specialists will also pay Pennsylvania Livestock Exposithe \$2.50 charge for any plant disease or nematode samples submitted to the Clinic




