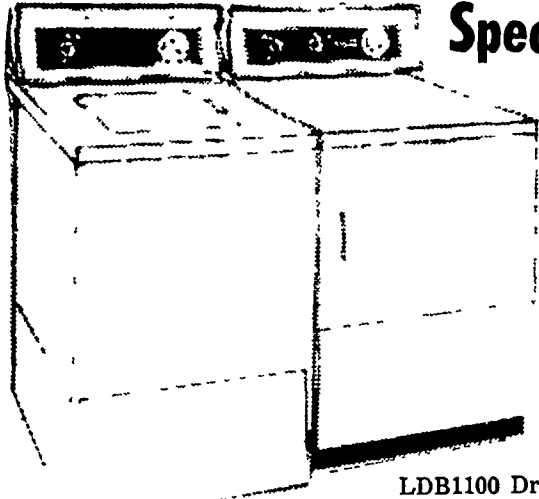

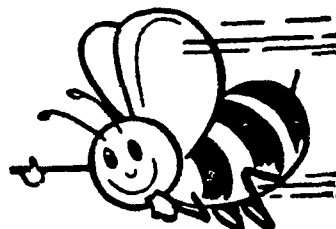

Brazilians Visit Co. Farm Loan Office

Nine men and a woman from Brazil were in Lancaster County Monday and Tuesday to study agricultural credit including bank, farm and FHA credit policies and methods for use in their own country.

The Brazilian delegation, which included bankers, agronomists and extension agriculturalists with the Northeast Bank of Brazil spent all day Monday and part of Tuesday in the office of Roy Geismann, Lancaster County Supervisor of the Farmers Home Administration, in the Farm and Home Center.

On Friday the group met with state officials responsible for directing the Farmers Home Administration program in the Federal Building, Harrisburg. They studied the administrative skills needed to make the agency's supervised credit program function smoothly.

Co. 4-H'ers Show Steers in Md.

Tuesday afternoon the group visited the farm of Paul Zimmerman, Lititz RD1.

Lancaster County 4-H members had three class meets at the Eastern States Livestock Exposition at Timonium, Md., last Saturday.

The Brazilians were slated to visit elsewhere in Pennsylvania until Friday before visiting New York. They previously had spent a week each in North Carolina, Louisiana, and Washington, D.C. under the Agency for International Development (AID) program.

Placings by local 4-H'ers in the steer competition include the following:

Don Dorwart, Quarryville RD1, was first and Sheyl Weaver, New Holland RD1, second in the Angus senior calf class. Billy Martin, of New Holland RD1, was first and Gary Eubaker, Rohrestown, second, in the late summer yearling Hereford class.

Nancy Herr, Penn Grant Road, Lancaster, was first, and Robert Hess, Mountville, second, in the Shorthorn senior calf.

Geismann said that the Brazilians represent an area where most land owners own only 10 to 20 acres, while most of the land is held in large ranches. A major objective of the trip here, he says, is to attempt to find ways to enable more Brazilian landowners to have adequate sized farms.

At Lancaster, the specialists studied real estate loans and credit assistance to rural groups, and in Perry County on Wednesday and Thursday they reviewed county operations and participated in round table discussions of the possible adaptations of Farmers Home Administration
