# Elvin Hess Re-Elected Pa. Holstein V-P

Elvin Hess Jr., Strasburg, York, was among four herds recognized for leading lactation averages and production achievements.

Other officers re-elected were: George Breidenbach, Martinsburg, president; Robert Curley, Montrose, treasurer, and William C. Nichol, State College, association secretary.

Elsewhere at the convention, the herd of J. Mowery Frey and Son, Lancaster, was among five herds recognized for high classification average and body conformation. George M. Knight Jr., Airville, was also included in the five.

Knight also received All-American honors for show ring winnings in 1969 and recognition for top sales consignments.

Ferndale Farms, Lebanon; Hertzler's Dairy Farm, Elizabethtown; and Jefferson Yoder, Elizabethtown.

Some local Holstein breeders received recognition for show ring achievement during 1970. The awards were made by the Pennsylvania Holstein Association of State College and the "Pennsylvania Holstein News" Office of Sandy Creek, New York.

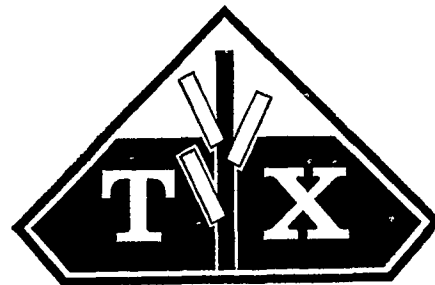
