Mrs E Clau Witmer will serve as an alternate to the convention to be held in Harrisburg January 11-12

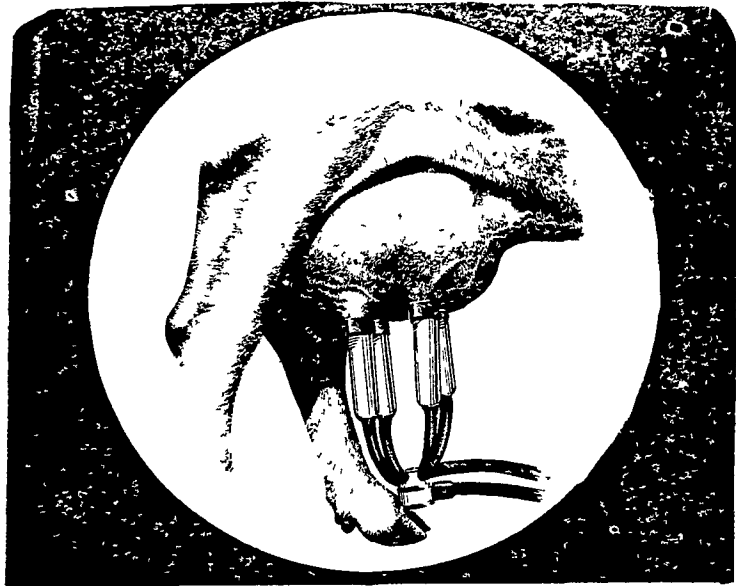
