U.S. to Inspect Poultry

The U. S. Department of Agriculture recently announced that poultry plants operating wholly within 14 States will be subject to Federal poultry inspection, effective Jan 2

The 14 States had requested Federal inspection or indicated they did not feel there was enough poultry business in their States to warrant establishing inspection systems.

The States are: Arkansas, Colorado, Georgia, Idaho, Maine, Michigan, Minnesota, Montana, New Jersey, North Dakota, Oregon, South Dakota, Utah, and West Virginia.

The U.S. Labor Department's Wage-Hour Division has launched a comprehensive effort to eliminate job vacancy advertising which discriminates against the hiring of older persons.

The age discrimination law prohibits employers of 25 or more persons, employment agencies, and labor organizations from discriminating against persons between ages 40 and 65 in hiring, discharge, promotion, compensation, and other areas of employment because of age.
