

# 1971 Wheat and Feed Grain Programs Okayed

New voluntary wheat and feed grain programs have been approved for 1971.

They include set-aside provisions but offer a great deal more flexibility in the selection of crop acreages than past programs according to Miss Dorothy Neel, Lancaster County ASCS executive director.

A domestic wheat allotment and feed grain base will be established for all eligible farms.

Feed grain will include corn and grain sorghum, but not barley.

There is no limitation on the acreage of wheat and feed grain that can be grown.

Farmers who enroll will be re-

quired to set aside a percentage of their domestic wheat allotment and/or feed grain base. Exact percentages will be announced at a later date.

In addition to this, they must maintain the conserving base established for the farm.

Wheat farmers can earn cer-

tificate payment on the domestic wheat allotment and feed grain farmers will earn price support on 50 per cent of the feed grain base.

Detailed information will be sent to all farmers when available, and it is expected that enrollment will start about March 1, 1971.
