

## Tennessee Guernsey Is Record Breed Producer

A Tennessee owned Registered Guernsey cow, Fox Run A F C Faye, has been crowned as the new Milk Champion of the Guernsey breed

Her recently completed official record, started at the age of five years and four months, was 32,110 pounds of milk and 1397 pounds of butterfat in 365 days on 2x milking and is the highest to date for a single lactation

The new champion is owned by Gale Housley and is maintained in the herd of Lee Housley & Son, Ridgeway Farms, Riceville, Tennessee. She was bred by James D O'Banion, Campbellsville, Kentucky

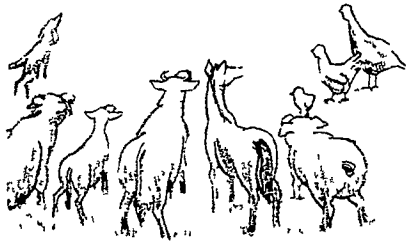
This brings the total of her first three lactations to 61,028 pounds of milk and 2691 pounds

of fat for an average of 20,341 pounds of milk and 897 pounds of fat, all on 2x milking. In addition to the Milk Production Champion of the breed, she now also holds the second highest butterfat record for the breed in a single lactation

Classified Excellent (94) for type, she climaxed a three-year career in the show ring by being named First Aged Cow and First Best Udder Aged Cow at the 1969 National Guernsey Show at the beginning of her championship record and was named All-American Aged Guernsey Cow in 1969

"Faye" already has two sons in artificial breeding service with the American Breeders Service

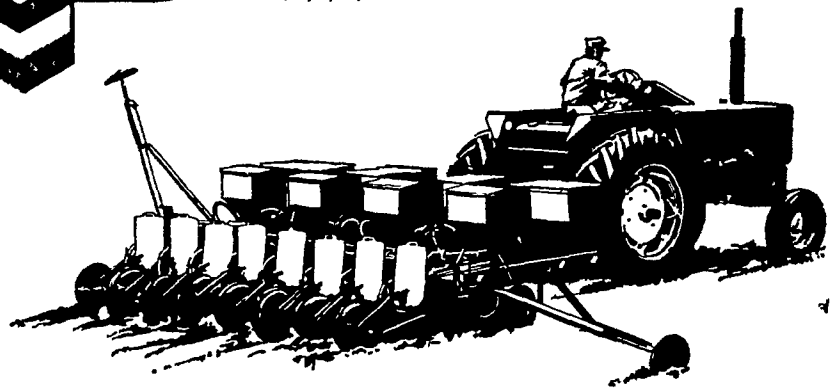
