New York Meat Inspection

The US. Department of Agriculture recently certified the New York meat inspection program equal to the Federal one, under provisions of the Wholesome Meat Act.

As a result, New York now has full responsibility for inspection of meat slaughtering and processing plants doing business wholly within the State The certification will affect 692 intrastate plants now operating there.

Meat Inspection Reinstated

The US Department of Agniculture announced recently that Federal meat inspection has been reinstated at Medallion Provision Inc., 1933 Reed St, Philadelphia

USDA's Consumer and Marketing Service said that plant management has agreed to abide by Federal inspection requirements


