Swine Results From Farm Show

Entries from Lancaster County in eight swine breed events were scarce this year at the Farm Show, but entries from neighboring counties, particularly York and Lebanon Counties, took many of the top swine awards

In the Landrace breed competition, Jay D. Blatt, Annville RD2, Lebanon County, had both the champion and reserve champion This is only the second year that Landrace have been entered in Farm Show competition

Glenair Farm, Elizabethtown RD3, however, had the second place entry in both Landrace classes, senior spring gilts and junior spring gilts Glenair Farm also was third in junior spring gilts

Indiana and Centre County entries took the top spots in Duroc competition, but Lancaster County had four Ruoss entries placing in the top 10 of two classes.

In senior spring gilts, W F Ruoss, Ephrata RD2, was fourth and Frank Ruoss, Ephrata RD2, was eighth In junior spring gilts, Dorothy Ruoss, Ephrata RD2, was fourth and eighth

The Glenair Farm and Ruoss entries were the only ones listed as among the winners in official Farm Show results

Top spots in other breeds went to farmers in neighboring counties as follows:

Chester White — Boyd Brothers, Brogue RD1, York County, both champion and reserve champion

Poland China — Eugene G Boeshore, Jonestown RD1, Lebanon County, both champion and reserve champion. He ex-

Hampshire — William H Sweigard and Son, Halifax RD2, Dauphin County, champion, and Kenneth C. McCleary and John E Strawbridge, Stewartstown, York County, reserve champion.

Berkshire — Gordon Shive, Seven Valleys, York County, champion, and Dennis Grumbine, Myerstown RD2, Lebanon County, reserve champion.

Yorkshire — John Strawbridge and C. Kenneth McCleary, Stewartstown, York County, champion These men also had the champion last year
