

Area Cattle Win Open Class Events

Southeastern Pennsylvania entries took most of the top awards in the open class beef cattle competition at the Farm Show this week

Except for a strong showing by a Susquehanna County farm in Herefords, three counties — Lancaster, Chester and Lebanon — took nearly all the top awards in both the highly contested Angus and Hereford open class divisions.

Dutchman Hereford Co Inc, Oxford RD1, Lancaster County, exhibited the Reserve Grand Champion Bull and the Reserve Grand Champion female in the Hereford competition.

Dutchman Hereford was second in both top spots to Keystone Hereford Co, Susquehanna County.

In the Angus division, Soleil Farms Inc., Downingtown RD1, Chester County, exhibited the Grand Champion Bull, while David Wylie, Nottingham RD2, Chester County, displayed the Grand Champion Female.

Reserve Grand Champion Angus Bull went to Twin Oaks Farm, Quarryville RD2, and Reserve Grand Champion Female to Octoraro Farm, Nottingham RD2.
