

## One of Nation's Best Dairy Breeders to Speak Locally

Wally Lindscoog owner of Arlinda Farms, Tullock, Calif., will be headline speaker at the Sixth Annual Southeastern Dairy Conference February 9 at the Guernsey Barn-Pavilion on Route 30 east of Lancaster.

Arlinda Holstein Farms, synonymous with being at the top, had the high herd nationally for milk and fat in the over 100 cow category.

Wally, always mindful with the importance of each and every mating to insure progress for future generations, has personally developed the herd to its present heights with only an occasional outside purchase. They raise all their replacements. Great effort has been made to achieve a fine herd balance with correctness of type and production.

Rigid attention to these details has provided the herd with 12 consecutive Progressive

Breeder Awards by the Holstein Association.

Just one of the many nationally known cows bred and developed at Arlinda Farms is AR-LINDA ABC DAFFY, first cow of any breed to have five records of 365 days or less each above 30,000 milk and 1200 pounds fat regardless of milking frequency. The herd of over 125 milkers is handled efficiently by one man in a specially designed four stall parlor barn.

This farm at Turlock, Calif., has also a most successful turkey hatchery, processing annually six to nine million turkey eggs. Lindscoog is an active adviser to the British government and is supplying them with his practical know-how regarding fertility problems and their present production is at an all-time high.

## County Farmers Assn. Meets

The Lancaster County Farmers Association board of directors agreed at its meeting Tuesday at the Farm and Home Center to hold its spring meeting March 12 at the Center.

Benjamin Weaver, Lancaster County Commissioner, will speak on a proposal for taxing land at its real use value, rather than market value. Weaver will discuss other farm-related issues.

It was announced that the Farmers Association will host a young group of 30 to 40 farmers from Tennessee in July. Further details will be announced later.

A regional membership rally will be held in Pottstown at the Holiday Inn on February 18, an-

nounced James G Kreider, local president. Any member wishing to attend should contact a county director, Kreider said.

Kreider also said that 904 members have been signed up so far this year. This is up from 831 last year, but is still short of the 1971 quota. The quota can be reached if everyone who attended the kick-off in early January signs up one more member, Kreider said.

Kreider signed three farmers for outstanding work in signing up new members: Titus Hess, Leola, who signed up 23 new members; Nathan Stoltzfus, Gap, and Moses Martin, Ephrata.

Meanwhile, Tuesday night, Eugene McDowell, regional Pennsylvania Farmers Association director, spoke at meetings of the Quarryville Rotary Club and the Solanco Young Farmers.
