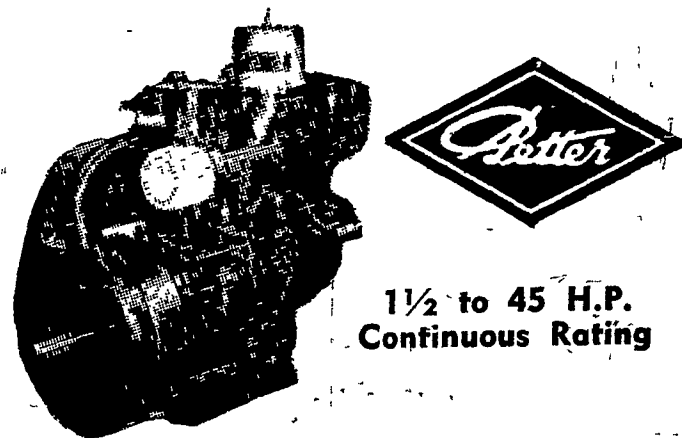
The assessment now being collected by the Association from its members for milk marketing and numerous other services designed to protect and benefit all dairymen in Eastern will be reviewed and acted upon.

Topics of discussion will include mandatory deductions for the purpose of milk advertising by dairy farmers in the northeastern states; super pools and their effect on the income of milk producers; increased cost of milk production compared to estimated blend prices for 1971; supply and demand picture and marketing conditions in the five federal order markets of the northeast region.

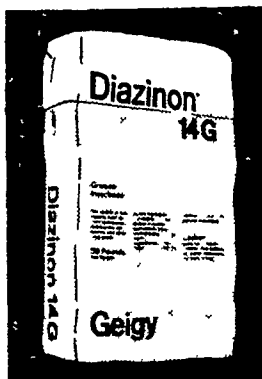
