#### Some Trends


With continued increases in pork quality, Moore projected that pork consumption in the U S could go from the present 65 to about 90 pounds per person by 1980 Meanwhile, beef consumption could go from the present 114 pounds to 150 pounds by 1980

This reflects a major trend of Americans toward much greater consumption of protein foods and less starchy foods

Partially offsetting the trends taward greater pork and beef consumption will be continued declines in veal and mutton consumption Daily cattle also account for a continually smaller share of the market In 1945 dany animals made up 45 per cent and beef 55 per cent of cattle while in 1970 daily had gropped to 19 and beef had risen to 81 per cent

At the same time there has been a major trend toward feed of production Some 70 per cnt of all beef cattle now are coming from feed lots, compared to only 33 per cent in 1947 The emainder comes from pasture or dairy animals


