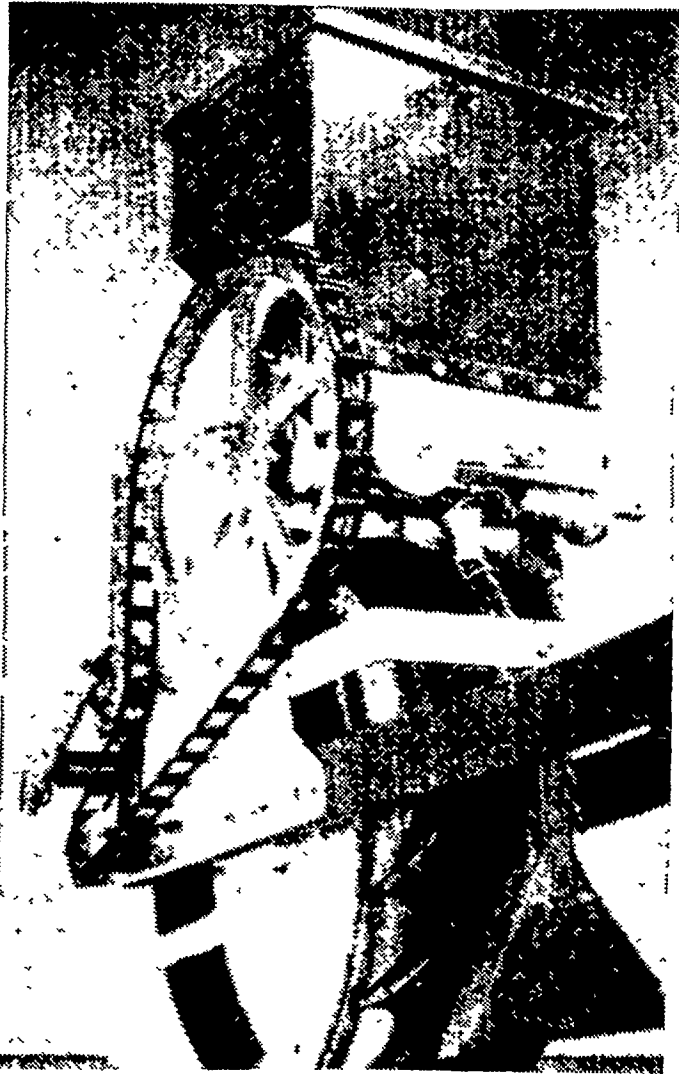


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Agway Drivers Get Safety Awards

Twenty-four area Agway truck operators received safe driving awards at an Agway dinner this week at York.

They are among 1,250 Agway drivers to receive the award this year for compiling safe driving records of one to 26 years.

More than 55 per cent of them completed more than five years without a chargeable accident.

Their driving record of 108 accidents for 100,000 miles was better than the national average of 131 accidents for all truck fleets reporting statistics to the National Safety Council.
