### Withholding Time Lengthened For Inoculated Carcasses

All meat-producing livestock and poultry must be withheld from slaughter at least 21 days after inoculation with biologics, the U.S. Department of Agriculture advised recently.

USDA slaughter inspectors have found objectionable needle marks in carcasses up to 21 days after meat animals had been inoculated with biologics. This finding caused officials in USDA's Agricultural Research Service to set the new minimum.

The previous ruling set with holding requirements as short as 14 days, and labels of many products now on the market still carry withholding requirements shorter than 21 days. However, livestock and poultry producers and their veterinarians should immediately observe the 21-day minimum period.

Manufacturers have been told to put the new instructions in the next printing of product labels, provided all labels are in compliance, by not later than December 1, 1971. Under the Virus-Serum-Toxin Act of 1913 ARS Veterinary Biologics Division is responsible for administering labeling and other regulations of veterinary biologics.

Division officials emphasize that some products like certain Anthrax Spore Vaccines, have withholding requirements longer than 21 days—and these longer requirements must continue to be observed. The new ruling affects only the minimum withholding period permitted.
