

The narrow producer exemption now in effect does not permoney to finance meat inspec. state exemption, "farmers who mit producers to retail unin-

> Producers who wish to continue to retail meat must take their animals to a plant where the animals are slaughtered under inspection or farmers must get their own facilities approved so the animals can be slaughtered under inspection at the farm.

> Since most farmers slaughter only small volumes of livestock, it will be impractical in most cases to apply for approval of small farm slaughter facilities.

> If a farmer has his livestock slaughtened at a plant under inspection, he is then free to retail his meat cuts and farm processed meats. As a small retailer, the farmer does not need a meat handlers license.

As a retailer, however, he is subject to the laws and regulations of the Pennsylvania Department of Foods and Chemistry. A farmer's meat offered for sale at a retail outlet will be subject to the same random sampling of product which representatives of this department apply to retail food outlets throughout the state.


