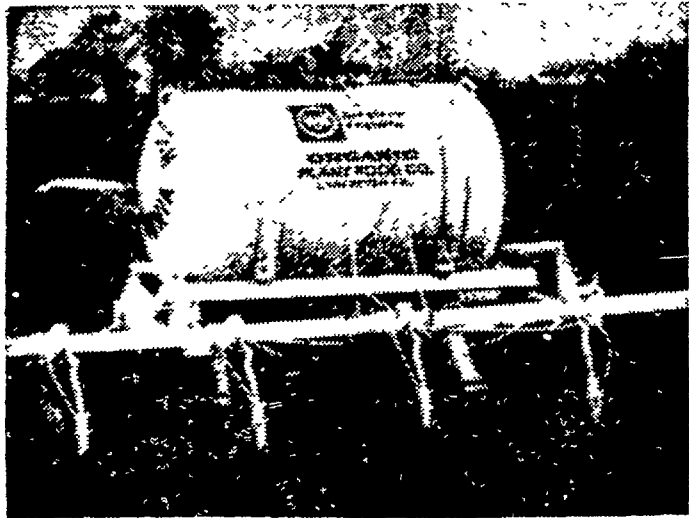

Making the presentation at the surprise party March 10 is Herbert R. Eshelman Jr., firm president.

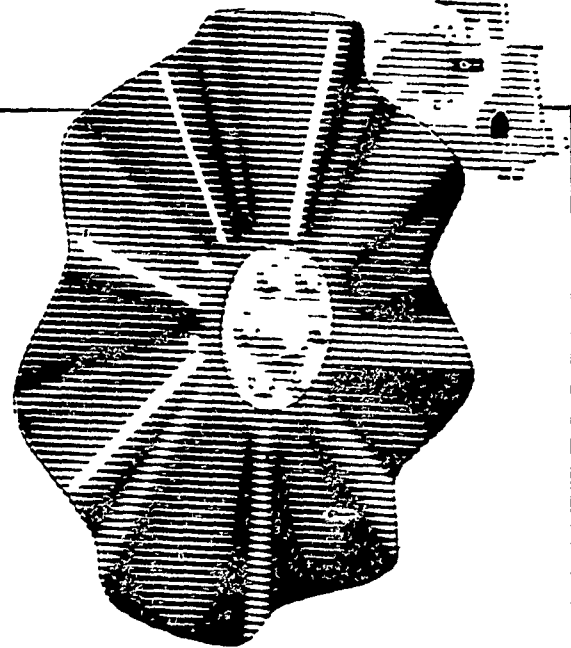
