

Pittsburgh Firm Is Cited Under PACA

National Fruit & Produce Co., 2008 Smallman Street, Pittsburgh, Pa., has failed to pay a reparation award of \$3,908 issued under the Perishable Agricultural Commodities Act, the U.S. Department of Agriculture reported recently.

Officials of USDA's Consumer and Marketing Service said the Pittsburgh firm has been found to be bankrupt. The firm's officers, directors and stockholders—Anthony Joseph Scarpaci, Joseph Leonard Scarpaci and Frank Thomas Scarpaci—are not entitled to conduct business under the PAC Act, nor may they be employed by any PACA licensee without USDA's approval.
