

## Registrations Increase In Feed Grain Program

Registrations by Lancaster County farmers in the U.S. feed grain program are up "probably because of no acreage limitation on corn," according to Miss Dorothy Neel, ASCS executive director.

The limitations on corn have been removed because of the scarcity following last year's blight.

So far, with the filing deadline April 9, some 251 farms are registered in the feed grain program with a base of 4,779 acres.

And 289 farms are in the wheat program with 1,059 acres of domestic allotment on which farmers can earn payment.

## 4 Township Government Seminars Set

Four government educational seminars for township supervisors have been scheduled to "focus upon current issues and problems common to township government in Lancaster County," according to Max Smith, Lancaster County agricultural agent.

Sponsored by the Lancaster County Association of Township Supervisors, the Lancaster

set aside 20 per cent of the base and farmers in wheat must set aside 75 per cent of the domestic allotment.

County Cooperative Extension Service and Pennsylvania State University, the seminars will be held in the West Lancaster Fire Hall, Columbia and Yale Avenue, Lancaster, from 7:30 to 9:30 p.m. April 14 and 21 and May 12 and 19.

Planned primarily for township supervisors, the meetings "are designed to bring about a better understanding of the operation of township government," Smith said.

Featuring guest speakers, the series is the first of its kind

to be sponsored in Lancaster County, Smith noted.

The first 40 minutes of each program will feature a presentation by the speaker, followed by a refreshment break. The remaining time will be used for a question-and-answer session. Each seminar will be centered on a particular concern of township government.

The subject for the evening and the guest speakers are:

April 14 — Howard Levine, president, Local Government Research Corporation, State College, Pa., "What is Local Government?"

April 21 — K. L. Shirk Jr., Lancaster Attorney, "Township Government Services."

May 12 — "Taxation and Finance" with Francis Geisler, Municipal Statistics and Records, Department of Community Affairs, Harrisburg.

May 19 — John Ahlfeld, planning director, Lancaster County Planning Commission, "Planning and Zoning."

The text used to supplement information presented in the seminars can be purchased at a cost of \$5.50 at the April 14 and 21 meetings.

The State Association of Township Supervisors, in cooperation with Penn State, will award certificates to all who successfully complete the text lessons related to the seminars.

The planning committee for the series is comprised of Wilmer Bolton, Robert Dye, Kenneth Funk, B. L. Greider, John Henry Hess, John Long, Howard Noll, all from the Lancaster County Township Supervisors Association; Max Smith, and Donald Harter, new Penn State Resource Development Agent, who serves as coordinator for the series.
