Place in casserole and pour the following cooked white sauce over it

- 1 qt liquid (use chicken broth and add milk to make 1 qt)
- 2 tablespoons butter
- 4 tablespoons flour

Top the casserole with 1 inch of dried bread crumbs, salt and pepper, which have been browned in butter. Bake at 350 degrees for 1 hour.

Mrs Herr put this recipe in the new Dinner Bell cookbook-

CHICKEN SALAD

- 1 medium chicken (cooked and diced)
- 1 cup celery (chopped)
- 1 cup white grapes (sliced)
- ½ cup chopped nuts
- 4 hard-boiled eggs (chopped)
- Parsley (optional)

Combine above ingredients and blend in the following cooked and cooled dressing

- 3 or 4 eggs (beaten)
- ½ cup sugar
- ½ cup vinegar
- 1 tablespoon dry mustard
- 1½ tablespoons cornstarch
- ¾ cup milk or cream
- ½ teaspoon salt
- 1 tablespoon butter

Mix cornstarch with a little of the milk and add to other boiling ingredients

UPSIDE DOWN PINEAPPLE HAM LOAF

- 7 cups ground cooked ham
- 1½ lb ground beef
- 4 cups soft bread crumbs
- 1 teaspoon mustard

- 1 teaspoon salt
- ½ teaspoon pepper
- 2 eggs (slightly beaten)
- ½ cup catsup
- 4 celery stalks (chopped fine)
- 2 medium onions (chopped fine)
- ¼ cup parsley (chopped)
- ½ cup brown sugar (packed)
- 5 canned pineapple slices & maraschino cherries

In bottom of 10" angel food cake pan sprinkle brown sugar and arrange pineapple slices and cherries. Combine all other ingredients in mixing bowl and mix well. Place meat mixture on top of pineapple and pat firmly. Bake at 350 degrees for 1½ hours. Remove from oven and pour off and save drippings. Invert on platter, pineapple side up. Spoon drippings over top. Serves 12-16

DEVILED EGGS

- 6 eggs
- ¼ cup salad dressing
- 1 teaspoon vinegar
- 1 teaspoon prepared mustard
- Salt
- Pepper

Hard boil eggs. Shell and cut in half. Mash yellow of eggs and combine with all other ingredients. Pile mixture into whites.

NEAT PARTY MINTS

- ½ stick butter
- ¾ lb 10X sugar
- 2 teaspoons peppermint extract (not oil of peppermint)
- ¼ teaspoon salt
- ½ cup water (hot)

Melt butter and add sugar, salt, water and flavoring. Mix well (A few drops of color may be added). Press through small cookie press or roll between hands and make in bite size pieces.

This recipe can be made ahead of time and popped in oven while you prepare other foods for serving.

HOT SANDWICHES

- 2 cups cooked chicken or turkey (diced)
- ½ cup celery (diced)
- 1 onion
- 1½ cups white American cheese (grated)

Combine all ingredients, except cheese, with enough of this cooled dressing to wet and hold it together.

- 1 cup water
- ½ cup vinegar
- 1½ cups sugar
- 1 teaspoon salt
- 2 small eggs (beaten)
- 2 tablespoons cornstarch
- 2 teaspoons mustard
- 1 cup milk

1 pt Miracle Whip. Mix water, vinegar, sugar and salt and bring to a boil. Add eggs, cornstarch, mustard and milk and cool until it thickens. Beat in Miracle Whip. Butter buns and spread mixture on with grated cheese on top. Wrap in foil and store in refrigerator. Bake at 400 degrees for 10 min. Dressing can also be used with potato salad.


