Donations to the Easter Seal Society, Cancer Drive and the Farm and Home Center were approved.

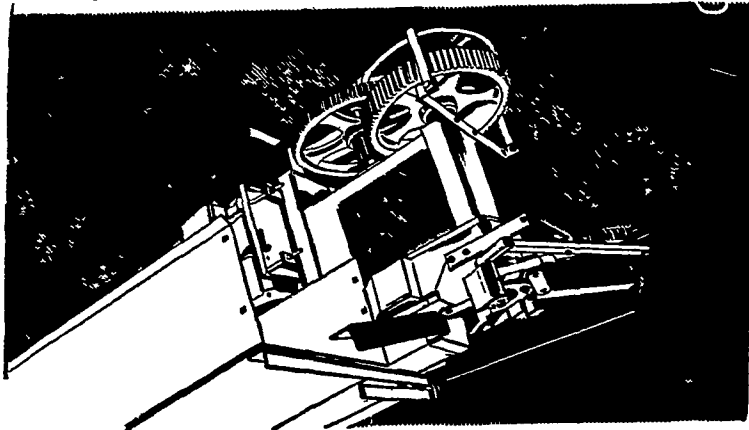
Announcement was made that "The Dinner Bell", a cookbook compiled by the Society,

## 6 U.S. Angus Auxiliary Scholarships Available

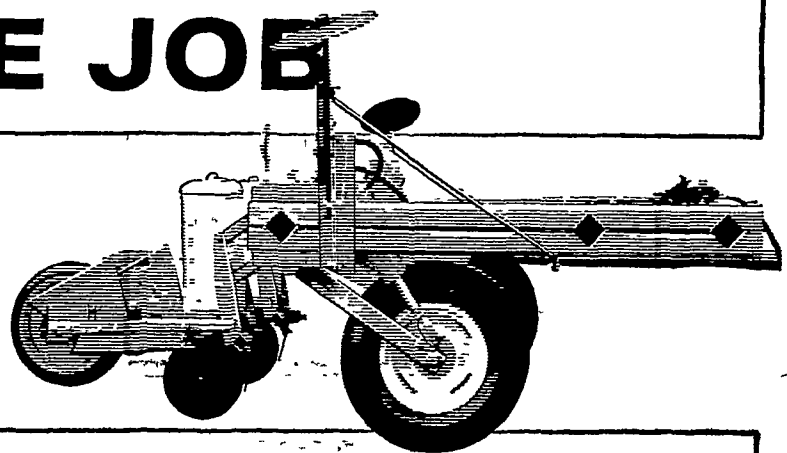

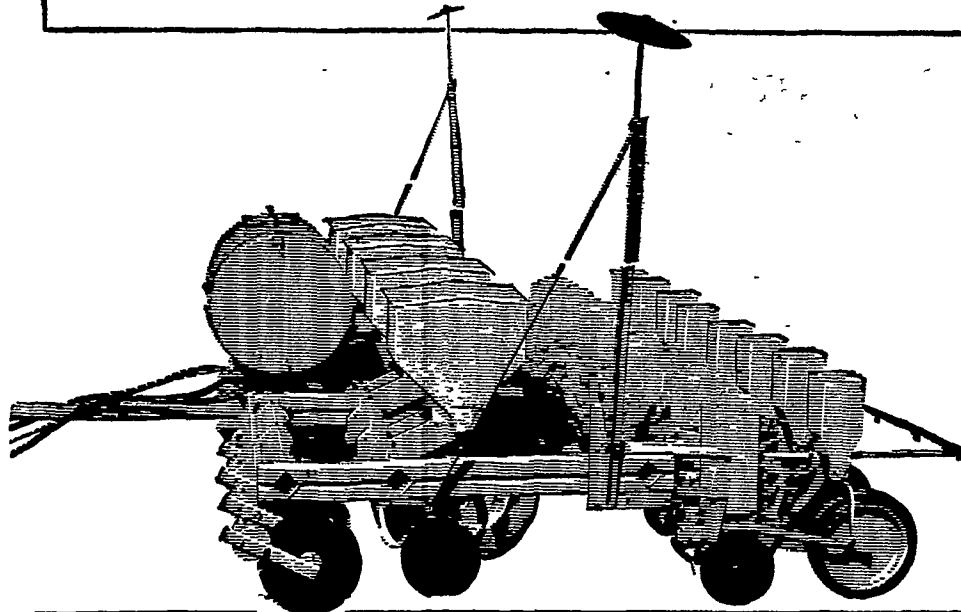
