

# Lancaster Club Hosts U.S. Pony Event

This summer, the Club will send some of the members to other clubs in the U.S. as exchange students.

are working with six handicapped children to teach them to love, care for and ride the more gentle horses provided by members of the club.

A "B" clinic will also be hosted by Lancaster Pony Club at their headquarters on April 17 and 18. The purpose of this event is to examine children from Eastern Pennsylvania on their riding skills to see if they are qualified to become "B" riders.

The contestants from Lancaster are Laura Lane, Patty Hassler, and Terri Moore. The examiners are Mrs. J. H. McConnell, Wilmington, Del., and Miss Jean Meston, Sommerville, N.J.

Lancaster will have their fifth annual Horse Show May 1 at the farm of John Gibson, Drumore.

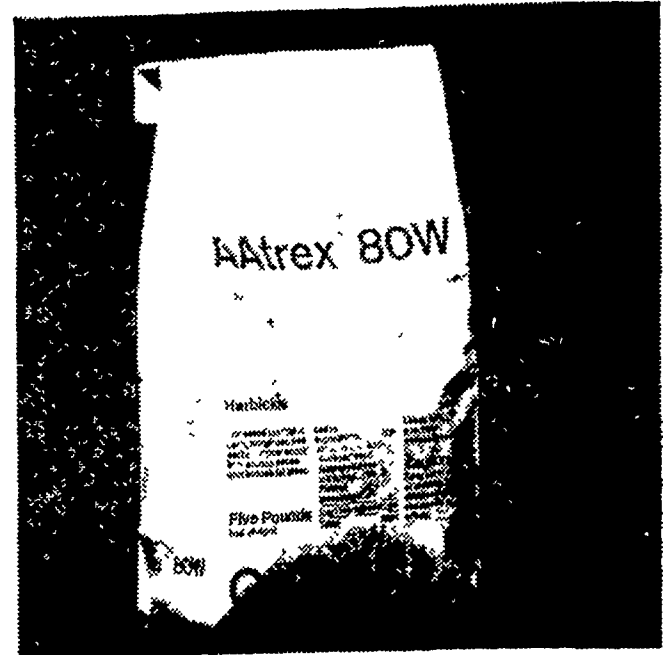

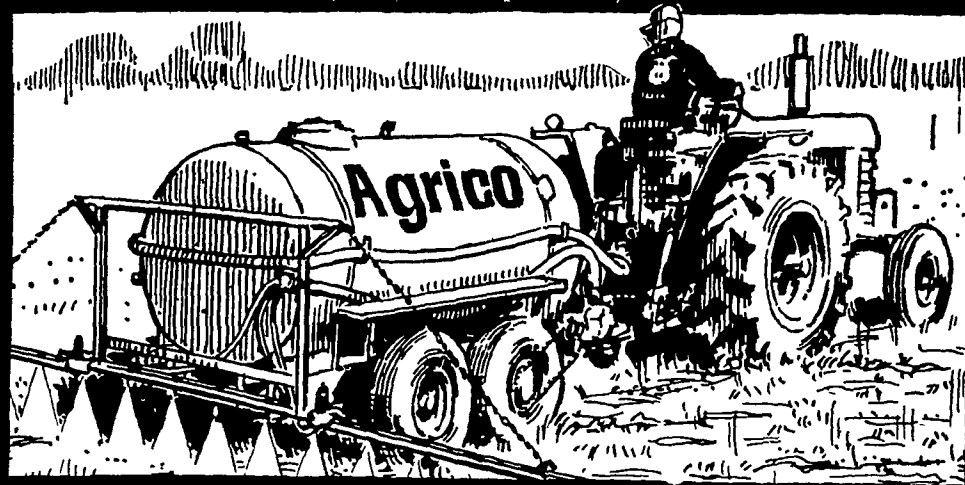
