- 12 slices bread crusts
- 3 beaten eggs
- 1 teaspoon onion flakes
- 1 teaspoon salt
- 1 teaspoon parsley flakes
- Dash of pepper
- Dash of celery seed

1 1/2 cups milk
 3 tablespoons butter
 Melt butter in skillet at low heat. Mix all ingredients together and put in skillet and stir often. This takes about 10 minutes. This can be baked in a moderate oven in a greased casserole for 30 minutes or more.

2 cups frozen peas
 1 cup diced carrots
 1/4 cup diced celery
 1 can cream of mushroom soup
 1 teaspoon salt
 1 hard boiled egg

Partially cook peas, carrots and celery to which salt has been added. Drain and add to chicken. Pour cream of mushroom soup

APRICOT DESSERT

1 4 1/2 package vanilla pudding mix
 Prepare as directions on package. In place of milk, substitute apricot nectar. Top with whipped cream.

RHUBARB DESSERT

4 cups rhubarb
 1 cup sugar
 2 3/4 cups water
 1 6 oz package strawberry Jello
 Cook rhubarb, sugar and water until rhubarb is tender. Remove from heat. Add the Jello and stir until dissolved. Pour into serving dish and chill.

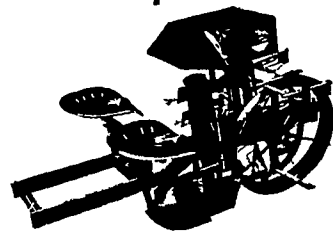
