> Slaughter Steers fluctuated somewhat apparently due to unevenly distributed Receipts on Monday on both prices of Steers and Heifers declined in face off increase marketing However, Mondays decline in Slaughter Steer prices was partially offset by an upturn on Wednesday. Wednesday receipts were curtailed after a down turn on Monday.

Slaughter Heifers experienced additional price weakness Wednesday.

Receipts 78 percent slaughter steers, 17 percent heifers, balance mainly cows. Overall finish of slaughter steers somewhat more attractive than last week with 15 percent prime, 70 percent choice This compares with 12 percent prime and 70 percent choice last week, and 11 percent prime and 78 percent choice last year
