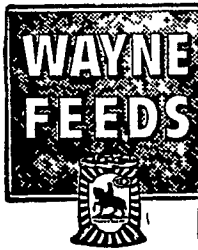
Conebella Patty was the purebred Ayrshire herd's best producer with 15,970 pounds of milk and 637 pounds of butterfat in 305 days.

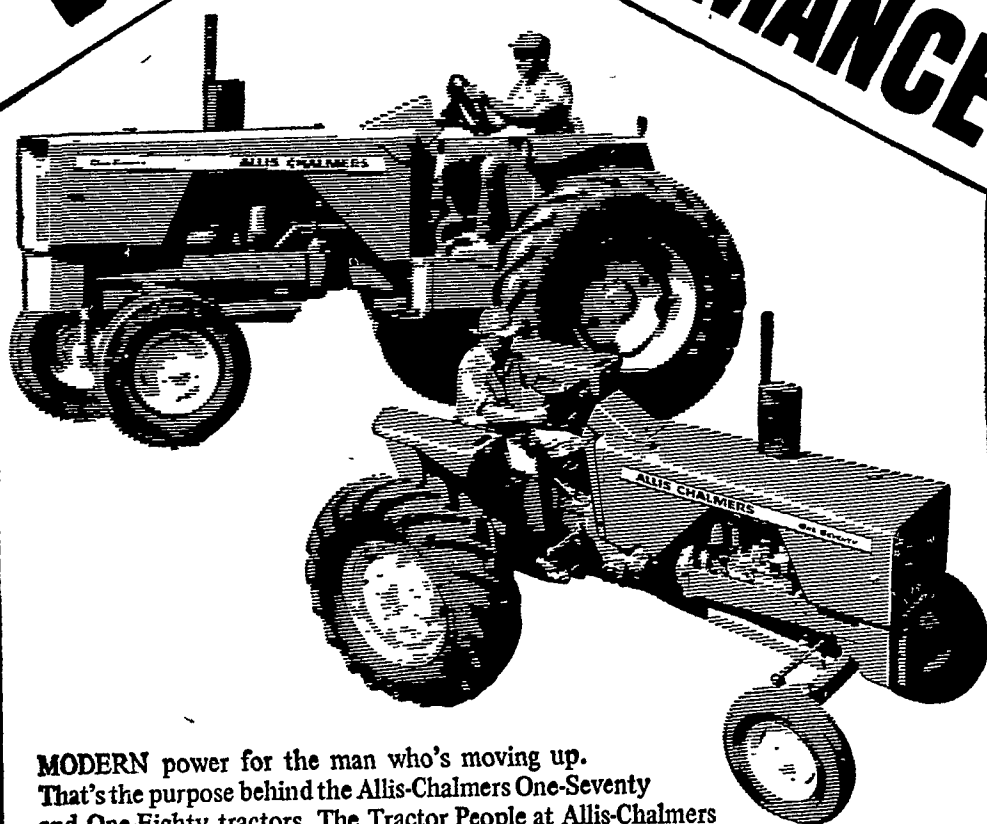
