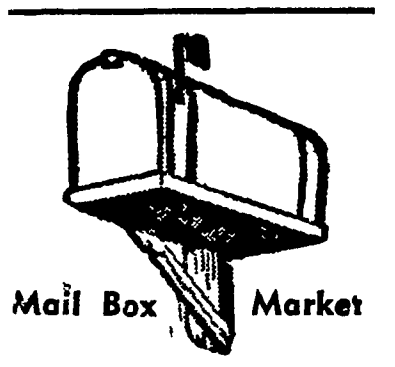

lin Stoltzfus would make reservations for the Club members to tour the New Bolton Veterinary Center on May 22.

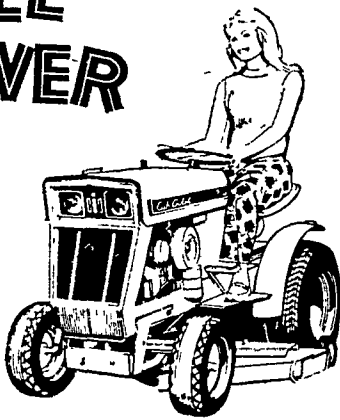
The next meeting will be held at the farm of Harold Coates where a showing and fitting demonstration will be given.

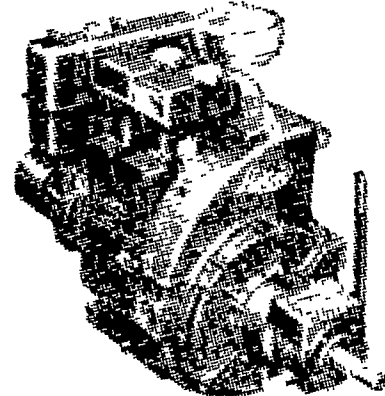
