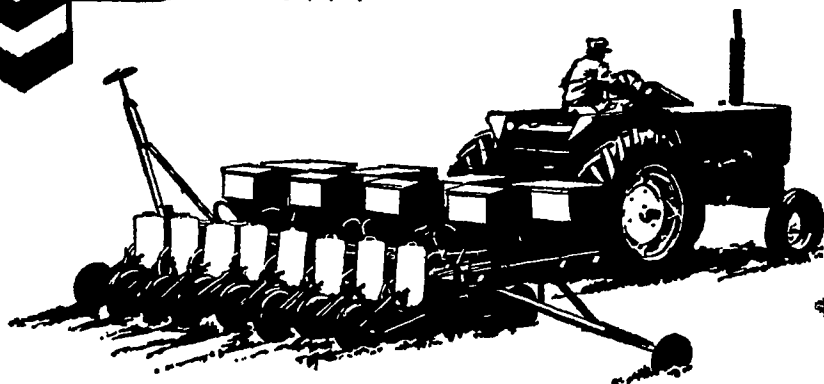
### Society 2
