Local Veterinary Student Graduates With Honors

Leon Dale Weaver, son of Mr. and Mrs. Lester M. Weaver, New Holland, graduated from the University of Pennsylvania with highest class honors in the school of veterinary medicine.

Dr. Weaver graduated Magna

Cum Laude and was awarded the Leonard Pearson Prize This award is presented to the class individual who, in the opinion of the veterinary faculty, has shown by his scholarship, breadth of interest, personality and high character that he is most capable of dignifying and advancing veterinary science in research, in practice in education, and in its relation to civilization

Dr. Weaver graduated from Garden Spot High School, New Holland, in 1964, and Goshen College, Goshen, Ind in 1967.

Dr. Weaver was president of his sophomore class, served on the student board of ethical relations and student faculty committee on discipline He was president of the student chapter of the American Veterinary Medical Association and was chapter delegate to Minnesota.

He participated actively in the formation of the National Conference of Student Chapters of the AVMA and was elected national chairman of the NCSC legislative committee He attended NCAC in Guelph, Ontario, and AVMA in Los Vegas and testified before US Senate and House subcommittees in behalf of veterinary medicine schools. Dr. Weaver served as secretary of Alpha BSI fraternity and was leader of two county 4-H veterinary science clubs.

Dr. Weaver is married to the former Nancy Jean Stoltzfus, daughter of Mr. and Mrs. Melvin R. Stoltzfus, Ronks He will serve his internship at Cornell University, Ithaca, N Y, in the outpatient ambulatory large animal clinic
