Registration in the "Purebred Registry" shall extend and be available to (1) males and females from registered Brown Swiss cows, (2) females from Identity Enrollment Brown Swiss cows, (3) males that are grandsons of Identity Enrollment Brown Swiss cows, (4) all females having not less than 7's Brown Swiss blood and (5) all bulls having not less than 15/16 Brown Swiss blood, provided that the sire in each case is a registered Brown Swiss bull or a registered Brown Swiss Beef bull and the dam of the % females and 15/16 bulls are recorded in the Brown Swiss Beef Cross Record.
