

Revised Poultry Inspection Rules Open for Comment

The U.S. Department of Agriculture recently proposed to revise the federal poultry inspection regulations to incorporate those changes called for by the Wholesome Poultry Products Act

The regulations cover every aspect of the Federal poultry

ing before-and after-slaughter inspection, plant sanitation, labeling, inspection of imported products, detention and seizure authorities, Federal-State cooperation, and many other inspection program — including specific details of inspection

USDA's Consumer and Mar-

keting Service explained that some sections of the proposed regulations remain unchanged, except for numbering or slight editorial changes which do not affect the intent of the regulations

Others update, clarify, or correct the regulations to keep pace with progress in the poultry industry.

C&MS officials said anyone wishing to comment on the proposal should send two copies of any statement by July 26 to the Hearing Clerk, Room 112-A, U.S. Department of Agriculture, Washington, D C 20250

Comments will be available there for public inspection.

The proposed regulations will be published in the May 27 Federal Register

Copies of the proposal are being mailed to poultry packers and other interested persons. They also may be obtained from Meat and Poultry Inspection Program, Administrative Group, Consumer and Marketing Service, U S Department of Agriculture, Washington, D C 20250.


