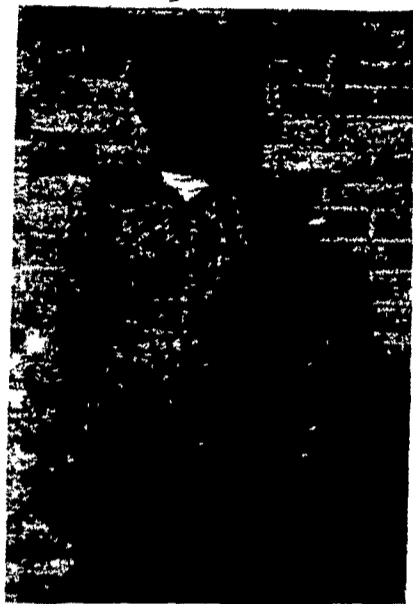

AGWAY SWINE NUTRITION SCHEDULE

YOUR FARM MIX

(without Grain Exchange*)

Mix 1 part Sow and Pig Supp.
Med. with 3 parts Farm Grains



AGWAY FEED

(with Grain Exchange*)

SOW FEED

From breeding time, feed 4 to 6 pounds per day depending on sow's condition. Part of feed may be replaced by silage, pasture or hay. Do not overfeed sows. Four weeks before farrowing, increase feed and decrease forage, if fed. By one week after farrowing, sows should be on full feed. Gradually decrease feed starting when pigs are 4 weeks of age. Flush sows just ahead of breeding, then repeat above schedule.
