WT. (Lbs.)	YOUR MIX (without Grain Exchange)*	AGWAY FEED (with Grain Exchange)*
40 to 75	Mix 1 part Sow and Pig Supp. Medicated with 3 parts of farm grains (100 pounds per pig)	16% Pig Feed
75 to 175	Mix 1 part Hog Grower Supp. Medicated with 7 parts of farm grains. (350 pounds per pig)	Hog Feed
175 to Mkt.	Mix 1 part Hog Finisher Supple- ment with 10 parts of farm grains (110 pounds per pig)	Pork Finisher

Note: Purchased feeder pigs that have been moved to your farm should have a special starting feed and treatment upon arrival. See your Enterprise Salesman.
