In horse judging, Center County was first, York County was second, and Dauphin County was third.

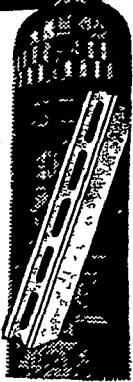
Local extension officials said Thursday that the Lancaster County showing was an unusually good one.
