

Korean 4-H Leader Will Visit Two Farms Here

A leading 4-H official from Korea will spend four weeks in Lancaster County, beginning Sunday.

He is Ki Hyung YOO, provincial 4-H leader in Kyunggi province, Korea. Jay W. Irwin, associate Lancaster County agent, explained that the position would correspond to the state 4-H club leader in this country.

YOO will spend the first part of his visit with the Glenn Porter family, Washington Boro RD1, and the remainder

with the James Hess family, Quarryville RD2.

His visit is being sponsored by the Professional Rural Youth Leader Exchange Program, conducted in the U.S. by the National 4-H Club Foundation in behalf of the Cooperative Extension Service. The program is carried out in cooperation with the Korea 4-H Club National Committee.

The 38 year old YOO has a BS degree in Agricultural Economics. His job includes planning and conducting various programs for the Provincial Office of Rural Development.

He is married and has three children. He speaks the Korean and Japanese languages and his English is listed as "fair." Irwin said YOO is very inquisitive about 4-H work and farming.

His rural experience includes a five acre home farm producing rice, vegetables, cattle and hogs.

His leisure interests include baseball, football and basketball.

In the area of 4-H and educational youth programs, he is particularly interested in information involving meetings and organizations, teaching methods such as visuals and demonstrations, projects and evaluation techniques, program planning and leadership training.

In the area of agriculture, he lists his interests as dairy cattle and milk production, beef cattle and hogs and meat production, mechanization in the

farm and home, and farm management practices.

He also cites an interest in family relationship and food supply, manufacturing including farm machinery, fertilizer and chemicals, recreational facilities such as parks and forests, and conservation of wildlife.

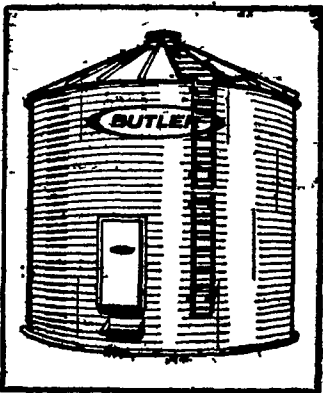

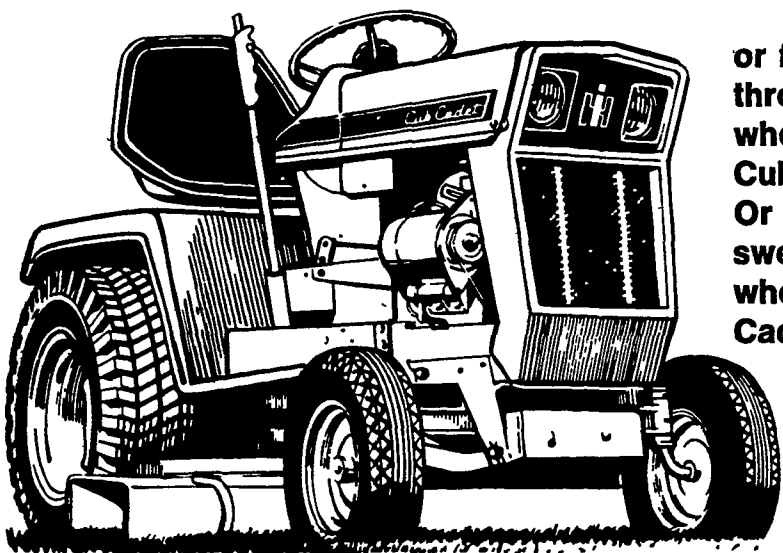

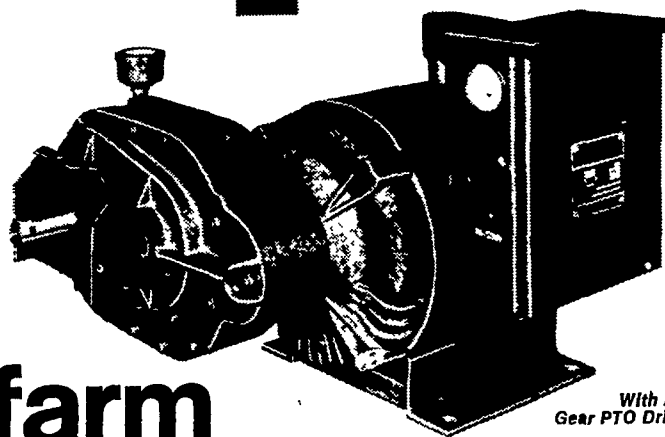
