The highly honored Premier Breeder Award, based on total points earned by exhibitors with entries placing high in individual classes, was won by H. S. Miller, Lime Rock Farm, with Arnold Acres the contender.

Premier exhibitor honors also went to Miller with Arnold Acres being the contender.

Elvin Hess Jr., Strasburg, served as judge for the 88 head of registered Holsteins.

Bank Hires Attorney

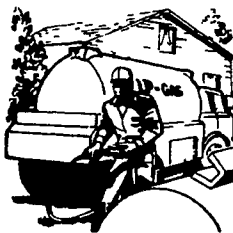

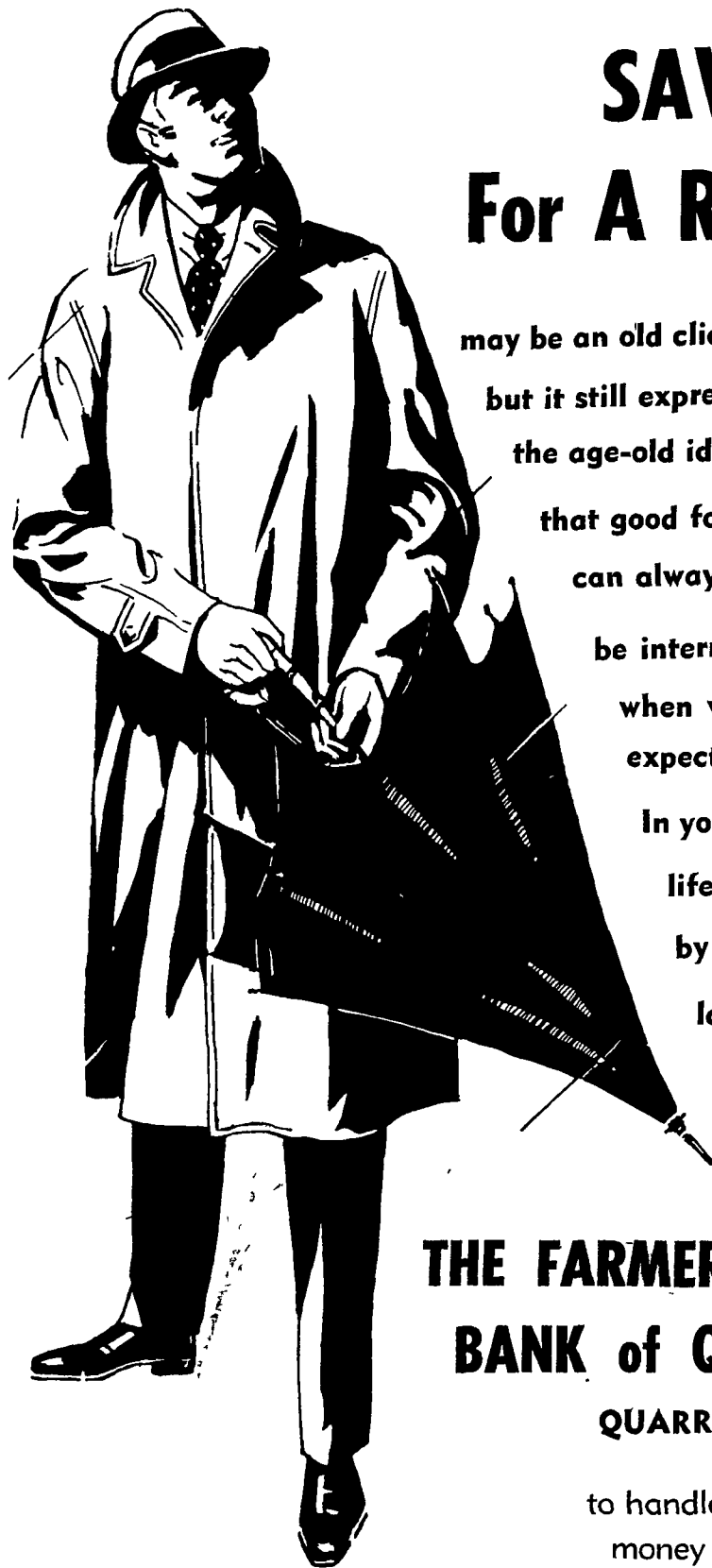

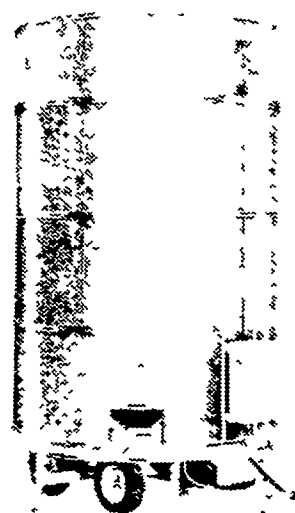
